

SYNCHRONISED SWIMMING

1. a) Only members of Sussex Clubs affiliated to A.S.A. S.E. Region are eligible to compete. Entry is subject to compliance with Condition 2 of the Associations Swimming Championship General Conditions.
b) No competitor may represent more than one club in any one calendar year.
2. The Synchronised Swimming Committee shall appoint the officials for County Championships and Age Group Competitions.
3. The entry fee shall be payable at the time of entry. Fees shall be reviewed annually and submitted to the Finance Committee for consideration at their meeting prior to the September meeting of the Management Committee.
4. Entries which are to be made in triplicate on the official entry form of the Association and accompanied by the fee must reach the Synchronised Swimming Meet Secretary 28 clear days before the event.
5. Entry Grade to be decided by the Synchronised Swimming Committee.
6. The Championship shall consist of different Figures/Technical Elements or technical Routines as decided by the Synchronised Swimming Committee.
7. Each swimmer who competes in the Figure/Technical Elements/Technical Routines shall be entitled to enter one Solo and one Duet.
8. If there are more than eight entries in the Solo and Duet Routine Championships only those competitors with the eight highest Figure/Technical Element/Technical Routine scores shall be permitted to compete, together with such additional junior competitors as to ensure a minimum of three junior competitors in the Solo and Duet Routine Championships.
9. Each Club shall be permitted to enter one team for the Team Routine Championship.
10. A medal shall be awarded to the winners of the Figures/Technical Elements or Technical Solo Routine and to those placed in second and third positions.
11. Seniors in the Solo and Duet Routines shall receive medals in accordance with their places. Juniors shall receive medals when so placed as well as the appropriate junior medals determined by the places.
12. A medal shall be awarded to each competing member of the winning Team Routine Championship.

The Regional A.S.A. Synchronised Swimming conditions shall apply, except as provided by these conditions.
