13.	Apologies as recorded.		
14.	The Minutes of the Meeting on the 1 December were approved and signed. (Deb O'Dell was not present at the December Meeting		
15.	 RTC – Mrs. O'Dell submitted a report on the work being done at the Triangle. 36 boys and girls (1999 – 2004 age groups) on the books but not a full attendance on most Sundays due to County matches, county swimming and illness. 7 Coaches + 3 helpers. Cost of the pool is £2000 per term (10 sessions) Most of the coaches were not claiming expenses. More Clubs in Sussex should be playing water polo especially the non-playing water polo clubs e.g. Atlantis, Crowborough, Eastbourne, East Grinstead, Horsham, Littlehampton and Shiverers. Rose Gallop e-mailed the Secretary late Monday (not picked up!) that she is proposing to start a Club at Crowborough. Ardingly Brighton and Hurst have been approached to participate with little response. Rural Kent and Rural Surrey Clubs to be approached for their members to be invited to the RTC. RCE to e-mail them. WP must target 12 – 14 swimmers dropping out of swimming. Sport England Funding only starts at 14+ which are too late for water polo. Suggested that RCE meets RG to draw up plans with 5 positive ideas which can be achieved. 		
16.	Splashpoint Mini Sessions. SE Region run training sessions for both Junior Boys and Girls squads on Saturday evening at Worthing) paid for by SE Region). The diving pool was unused and hence Steve Bond, Ewan Partridge and Alastair Roberts agreed to run Mini Water Polo Sessions at the same time free of charge. 36 boys and girls turned up on 17 January. On 31 st January, a 2 nd session was held with slightly less manageable numbers. More sessions will be run. Children from non-playing swimming clubs turned up.		
17.	 Finance The Secretary reported that he had attended the last 2 Management Meetings where the Budget for 2015-16 was discussed. He made the following points: Sussex ASA gets no money from the ASA. Swimming subsidises the diving, synchronised swimming and water polo effectively paying for entry fees for the 5 County SE/London Tournaments and entry for Sussex teams to enter the London Winter and Summer Leagues. There was a total deficit of over £8000 on the disciplines applications. Hence the need for areas to decrease this figure. 1st December we agreed £160 per Club. Sussex ASA Treasurer submitted a proposal that this should be £175. After considerable discussion (not all positive), it was agreed that each club should pay £175.
